How to get into Copenhagen

Coming from the airport, the easiest way is to take the metro to Kongens Nytorv or Nørreport. You need to buy a ticket for 3 zones, it costs DKK 36.


How to get around in Copenhagen

You will have access to a bicycle from Monday morning to Tuesday afternoon. A bicycle will usually be the fastest and easiest option in central Copenhagen.

For route guidance you can use <u>Google Maps (www.google.com/maps</u>), it is quite well updated with specific bicycle information. Google Maps will also work if you are walking. Sunday evening you will get a paper version of Copenhagen Bicycle Map (you can also <u>download the map here</u> or <u>here (English version)</u>).

Public transport trips can be found with <u>rejseplanen.dk</u> - here you can type in addresses or terminals and get proposals including the walkway to or from the station or terminal.

Special rules for cycling



Be aware that turning left on a bicycle in Denmark is done in two steps: 1) continue to the opposite corner of the intersection. 2) bike in the new direction (left to the original direction) once the road is clear in both directions. Stay at the right hand side of the street all the time.

How to get out of Copenhagen

Usually hotels offers to store your luggage. We advise you to do this, and to pick up your luggage on the way back. The easiest way to come to the Airport is to take the metro from Kongens Nytorv or Nørreport. You need to buy a ticket for 3 zones, it costs DKK 36.
